Target level on the supplier card and Export.

This change allows buyers to view supplier's target level on the supplier's card in the search results. This change means that buyers can understand at a glance what plan the supplier has signed up for.

This change introduces a status next to both the current and target levels. This change was introduced so that it is easier to identify the supplier status against the plan they had bought as well as the level they are currently on.

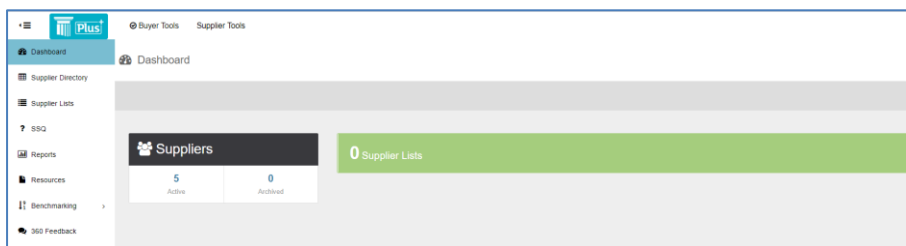

Constructionline Plus

Constructionline Plus is an add on to Constructionline. It is launched from within the Constructionline platform and enables additional features for both buyers and suppliers.

Once set up, buyers get additional features to help organisations manage their suppliers to their own standards beyond the initial Pre-qualification stage. This includes SSQs (the creation of bespoke questionnaires sent to specified suppliers), buyer requirements which is the extra level of prequalification geared specifically to the buyer, along with a supplier benchmarking capability and the ability for buyers to score their suppliers for work on a project and vice versa.
