




This best practice guide is designed to help contractors get the best from Once For All Market Intelligence.




## Use Case 1

I want to find new project leads and reach out directly to the correct person at the relevant principal contractor.

#### How to find this information:


1 Search via the drop down filters at the top for region, project category or type, contract type and created date or contract value.



- 2 Browse the projects that arise from your search filters. Once a project lead is found and you know the main contractor involved. Head to the next step.
- Move to the 'Company Office Contacts' tab.



4 Filter by the company name at the top of the page and the contact details of the relevant person(s) display.






# ? Use Case 2

I want to compare the number of builds we are winning with a regional average to understand our performance vs our competitors.

#### How to find this information:

- 1 Click on the Quarter Analysis tab. Pick your region, project category, project type and the year quarter you are interested in. Leave contract value as is.
- 2 Then export the data using the '...' shown in the middle of the right hand side of the screen.
- Then select the other contractor(s) you are interested in and view the number of projects they have been awarded in that time period.








I want to understand which principal contractors are getting the most projects.

#### How to find this information:

1 Click on the Awarded Projects tab then add a date range filter.



2 Then click on the 'Awarded Date' to see newest first. Projects awarded recently, along with the winning principal contractor are shown at the top.






I want to find the contact details of all architects, estimators and quantity surveyors in a particular principal contractor.

#### How to find this information:

Select on the Individual Company Data tab.



All professionals that work within a main contractor can be found as highlighted on the screen.



# Use Case 5

I want to understand which main contractors a particular client (eg a County Council) generally work with. I can then approach the right principal contractors to be best positioned to work for that particular client.

#### How to find this information:

Our new Working Relationships tab supports your business development: filter by company name, or by role, or region, and see which contacts are working with main contractors you're interested in, and their projects.
